Issues with marriage and family, mental health, caregiving, and bereavement are rapidly growing. It can be overwhelming for individuals and the churches to cope with, yet to seek counselling comes with many financial barriers and stigma.

Living Water Counselling Centre (LWCC) wants to enable churches to make Christian professional counselling support available to all of the congregation. Most of all, we want to remove the access barriers and promote holistic health for ethnic faith communities by introducing CAP-M.

The Congregational Assistance Program-Multilingual (CAP-M) is a wholistic health professional counseling package offered to the church congregation in need. The Church will sign up with LWCC and pay for the coverage annually.

## The CAP-M coverage includes:

- 1. Free access to Christian professional counselling up to 8 sessions per household per year.
- 2. Easy and quick access to Christian licenced professional counsellors (e.g. Registered Psychotherapists, Registered Family and Marriage Therapists, Registered Social Workers, etc.). For more counsellor profiles, visit our webpage.
- 3. All personal information will be kept confidential in accordance with the professional code of ethics.
- 4. Multi-lingual: Cantonese, Mandarin, English, and other Dialects.
- 5. Call the LWCC at 905-763-0818 for CAP-M. We will either assign you a counsellor in 7 days or refer you to other community resources.
- 6. Counselling/psychotherapy services are available Self-Esteem in-person, through telephone or virtual meeting.
